

**TOWN OF RISING SUN  
RESOLUTION 2011-04**

**DESIGNATION OF PORTIONS OF MOUNT STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the Town, located in Cecil County, Maryland is a municipality organized under and governed by Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 4 of the Town Code, titled Traffic Vehicles and Transportation, Article 1 titled Parking Regulations, section 4-103 titled Powers of the Board of Commissioners to Regulate Traffic Control Devices and Signs, gives the Board of Commissioners the authority to regulate vehicular and pedestrian traffic and parking areas; and

**WHEREAS**, an issue has been raised regarding the safe passage and conveyance of vehicles along Mount Street between Main Street and Pearl Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the board of Commissioners wish to consider a resolution designating the residential portion of Mount Street, between Main Street and Pearl Street, to one way; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief was requested to perform a general analysis of the impact of such a change and to provide his findings at a Special Meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission did give notice of a Special Meeting concerning this resolution, which appeared on August 5 and August 8th, 2011 in *The Cecil Whig*, and notice was also posted at the Town Hall and copies of such Resolution were provided for the public's review; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission did conduct said Special Meeting on August 9, 2011 at Janes United Methodist Church, in order to receive public comment thereon; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has reviewed the Police Chief's report and has considered all comments received from residents during the Special Meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners believe it is appropriate and necessary for the public good, safety and convenience to convert the residential portion of Mount Street, between Main Street and Pearl Street to one way, in order to facilitate the safe passage of vehicles.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners authorize the appropriate steps to install the necessary signs and other devices necessary to convert traffic flow along Mount Street, between Main Street and Pearl Street, as follows:

The section of Mount Street, just North of Main will remain open to two-way traffic, running North and South, up to the beginning of the residential section, located at #9 and #10 Mount Street. From this point, and heading North towards Pearl Street, the remaining section of Mount Street will be converted to one-way traffic only in the North bound Direction. This new traffic pattern will end at Pearl Street. All other sections of Mount Street will be unaffected by this change.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Rising Sun passed, approved and adopted this resolution on this 9<sup>TH</sup> day of AUGUST, 2011
