St. Patrick's Day Facts

- 1. The Real St. Patrick Was Born in Britain in either Scotland or Wales, not Ireland. His real name is Maewyn Succat.
- 2. St. Patrick was never canonized (officially declared a saint) by the Catholic Church because he lived in the 4th century, before the church began canonizing saints.
- 3. Leprechauns are mythical creatures that are part of the Irish folklore. Legend says they are shoemakers who hide gold coins in pots at the end of rainbows.
- 4. Four-leaf clovers are rare and are considered lucky.
- 5. Irish-Americans introduced corned beef to the holiday, and cabbage was a cheap vegetable available to Irish immigrants.
- 6. The holiday is also known as St. Paddy's Day because the Irish name for Patrick is Padraig.
- 7. Ireland's first St. Patrick's Day parade was held in Waterford in 1903.
- 8. The fountain in front of the White House is sometimes dyed green, and the streets of downtown Rolla, Missouri are painted green.




Opening Day for the Rising Sun Little League is Saturday, April 5, 2025

Location: Public Works Garage, 10 Dairy Street, Rising Sun, MD

Time: 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon First come, first serve!

This dumpster day event will only accept the following items: Household waste, metal goods, and most large, bulky items. Mattresses and Box Springs must be covered to be accepted. Items not accepted: TVs and other electronics, tires, yard waste, or hazardous waste.

*On-site Public Works staff reserves the right to refuse materials.

Items not accepted can be taken to the Cecil County Central Landfill at 758 E. Old Philadelphia Rd., Elkton, MD 21921, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. (prices vary)

The "Residential Dumpster Day" will not accept any items from commercial or private haulers, contractors, or landlord/rental unit clean-outs.

Larger vehicles limited to pick-up trucks, passenger vans, or trailers with a max length of 8 ft.

Upon arriving, remain in your vehicle.

Have your proof of Town residency available (ex. driver's license, utility bill, tax or water bill).

Residents must unload their own material; Public Works employees will only be available to operate the equipment, not to physically assist anyone.
