***This is not an emergency. This is not a violation of drinking water standards.***

Dear Customer,

Chester Water Authority is providing this notice to inform customers of a temporary interruption in the addition of Fluoride to the public drinking water supply beginning on or about April 1, 2026. We have notified the PA Department of Environmental Protection regarding this matter.

Fluoride is added to drinking water as a public health measure to help prevent tooth decay. Fluoride addition is not required for water safety and your drinking water will continue to meet all state and federal primary drinking water standards and remain safe to drink. This interruption is due to supply chain disruptions affecting the availability of fluoride treatment chemicals. Chester Water Authority is actively evaluating supply options and regulatory considerations and intends to resume fluoridation treatment once supply becomes available and operational conditions allow. ***We anticipate our fluoride delivery to arrive on or about April 3, 2026. We anticipate that we will be able to resume fluoridation by approximately April 4, 2026. We will issue another notification once that delivery is received.***

#### **Are there any health concerns?**

There are no adverse health effects associated with this temporary interruption. Customers concerned about dental health, including parents of young children, may wish to consult their dentist or healthcare provider.

#### **What should I do?**

No action is required. Alternative water supplies are not necessary.
